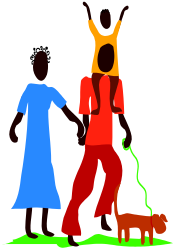

Welfare Benefits Advice helps people to claim and retain all the Social Security Benefits they are legally entitled to receive. Unfortunately many people are still unaware of their legal rights, especially with the ever changing face of the benefits system, the names of benefits and the name of the agency itself.

Advice sessions are provided at various health and community settings. For the housebound a home visiting service is available
